BOOKING TICKETS

01 // ONLINE

The quickest and easiest way to purchase your ticket is via our eticketing website - www.eticketing.co.uk/pompeyfc

On this site, you can select from all our available on sale fixtures to watch the Blues, whilst also having the option to see the view from a variety of seats around the stadium before purchasing.

02 // PHONE

Fans can purchase match tickets by calling our ticket office team on **0345 646 1898**. Once dialled you will be redirected to the ticket office by selecting **option 1**.





BOOKING TICKETS

03// IN PERSON

I // NON MATCHDAYS

On non-matchdays, tickets can be purchased from the ticket office in our Club Shop located on Anson Road (PO4 8TB).
Ticket Office is open Monday - Friday, 9:00am - 5:30pm

ii // MATCHDAYS

On matchdays, tickets are also available from our ticket office in Frogmore Road (PO4 BRA). They can be brought from 9:00am until half-time for weekend games, and from 5:30pm until half-time for evening kick-offs.





WHICH STAND

01// SOUTH STAND

Built in 1899, the stadium's oldest stand is full of history and character, whilst proving fantastic views. The stand is home to the majority of the club's Hospitality lounges as well as our designated family area - Nelson's Family Zone!

03 // NORTH STAND

This two-tier stand holds the largest number of supporters at Fratton Park! This fantastic stand provides great views of the pitch and brings you closer to the action than any other location.

02 // FRATTON END

Opened in 1997, this 4,500-capacity stand is known for helping create an incredible match day atmosphere, with the particularly vocal members of the fanbase loacted behind the Fratton End goal. This is also where our disabled supporters can enjow watching Pompey.

04 // MILTON END

This is where away supporters are housed. However, this stand also provides additional seating for home supporters in certain games. Here you are situated behind the Milton End goal.



YOUR TICKET

01//STAND

This confirms which stand within the stadium that you are seated in.

05 // TURNSTILES

These are the turnstiles you should use when entering Fratton Park.

02 // SEAT

Confirmation of what Block, Row and Seat you will be sitting in.

06 // BARCODE

Insert this section into turnstiles. Ensure this is not damaged as it may

03 // CUSTOMER ID 04 //

Your unique customer number - useful when booking future tickets.

07 // FIXTURE

Confimation of the game that the ticket is valid for.

04 // PRICE

The total cost paid for your matchday ticket.





TRAVELLING BY CAR

01// FROM THE WEST / MIDLANDS

Continue along the M2T eastbound (ignoring the M275 turn off for Portsmouth city centre) on to the A2T. At the junction with the A2O30 turn right towards SouthseaFratton. Continue along the A2O30 and eventually you will see the ground in front of you.

03 // FROM THE EAST (SUSSEX)

Continue along the A27 westbound. At the junction with the A2030 turn left towards Southsea/Fratton, Continue along the A2030 and eventually you will see the ground in front of you.

02 // FROM THE M25

Continue along the A3 southbound, which becomes the A3(M) and then joins the A27 westbound. At the junction with the A2030 turn left towards Southsea/Fration. Continue along the A2030 and eventually you will see the ground in front of you.



PARKING

01// DETAILS

There is limited parking around Fratton Park and please note that parking restrictions might be in place in the roads around the stadium on a matchday.

Entrance to the club car park is via Anson Road, off Rodney Road. The postcode is PO4 8SX. Spaces are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, with a charge of £10 per vehicle.

There is no entitlement to a specific space and stewards will allocate parking according to operational need.





TRAVELLING BY TRAIN

01// DETAILS

The nearest train station to Fratton Park is 'Fratton'.

Once at Fratton Station, exit via the footbridge and turn left onto Goldsmith Avenue. Continue along for approximately half a mile and Frogmore Road is on your left. Fratton Park is situated at the bottom.





STADIUM FACILITIES

01 // FOOD & DRINK

Once inside Fratton Park, refreshments are available in the stadium concourses.

You will be sure to find something to suit all tastes and budgets with a variety of hot food, snacks and drinks available. Most units are also equipped with fast pour capabilities and accept contactless payment transactions.

Supporters seated in the Fratton End also have the additional benefit of being able to access the bars situated within the Victory Lounge during the half-time period.

VICTORY LOUNGE

01// DETAILS

The Victory Lounge is a bar at Fratton Park that is open for ticket holders on matchdays. The bar is a popular meeting point for supporters both pre and post-match.

The bar is regularly open from 12pm for a 3pm kick-off and from 5pm for a 7.45pm kick-off, although supporters are advised to check our social media channels on the day of the fixture for any potential changes.

The room can hold a maximum of 500 supporters and offers a variety of alcoholic and soft drinks, with a variety of hot food options from the food hatch.

01 // MEET NELSON

From 45 minutes before the game, you will have the chance to meet the famous Pompey mascot Neison, who will walk around the side of the pitch ready to take some selfies or sign a shirt.

02 // THE BIG SCREEN

You can enjoy our big screen located above the Milton End before and during the match. Fratton Live starts 45 minutes before the game, so don't miss out on the chance to get onto the big screen!

03 // NELSON'S CLASSROOM

CLUB SHOP

01 // DETAILS

The Pompey store is located behind the North Stand in Anson Road and is also home to our Ticket Office.

Set up in partnership with Just Sport, it stocks a wide range of Nike-branded Blues clothing, as well as other accessories, including a variety of pocket money items for junior fans.

02 // OPENING TIMES

Monday-Saturday: 9am-5.30pm

Sunday: Closed





DISABLED FANS

If you require support once in the stadium, please contact the matchday DLO, who will be wearing hi-vis jacket number 301.

01 // PARKING

26 Accessible parking spaces will be made available to home and away fans. The club allocates these spaces on a strictly first-come, first-served basis, so we advise early arrival.

02 // WHEELCHAIR USERS

Fratton Park has 58 wheelchair and companion spaces situated in the front row of the Fratton End.

03 // AMBULANT SUPPORTERS

Proof of the highest rate of Disability Living Allowance or PIP will need to be shown to qualify for the concession.

These tickets are only available direct from the ticket office.

04 // REFRESHMENT AREAS

The ground level catering kiosk at the south-west corner of the Fratton End has wheelchair-accessible counters and serves food and drinks. The Pompey Supporters' Trust – supported by Miko Coffee and Comax – provide a complimentary tea and coffee service for wheelchair supporters and their assistants at half-time.

05 // ACCESSIBLE TOLIETS

There are five accessible toilets in the stadium, located at either end and in the centre of the Fratton End (West Stand). There is also an accessible toilet in Nelson's Family Zone and another in the north-west corner, adjacent to the accessibility office. They operate with RADAR keys, if you require a key, please contact the matchday DLO or a steward, who will assist.
